TIPS FOR EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION

Choose the quiz type



Quizzes can be tailored to specific objectives and content using different question types and formats such as multiple choice, true/false, fill in the blanks or matching, depending on resources and preferences.



Make sure you select the format that is more appropriate to the group you are working with.

2 Decide when to quiz



Pre-quizzes assess learners knowledge and expectations, post-quizzes assess learning outcomes, reinforce key points and provide feedback, while presentations use quizzes to engage and summarise information.



Make sure you use the quiz at the right time to add value to your training.

3 Personalise the quiz



Quizzes are a powerful tool for engaging and motivating adult learners, assessing progress and providing feedback. They can be personalised with groups of any size.



Make sure you use personalised questionnaires that adapt to the profile of your learners.

REFLECTING ON THE TECHNIQUE

When selecting quiz questions to put to your group of adult learners, consider group composition and background on the sustainability topic of the training to ensure effective assessment of understanding. Offering a variety of formats and tools can cater to different learning styles and preferences, making the assessment experience more inclusive and accessible to all. This ensures active participation in the learning process.



So, you should ask yourself one question:
Will my group benefit from gamified or interactive quizzes with
elements of fun and competition or will they prefer more
traditional quizzes?

By assessing adult learner's knowledge before and after a presentation, trainers can effectively measure the effectiveness of their training and make any necessary adjustments. In addition, quizzes during presentations serve as interactive tools that keep learners actively engaged and promote better retention of information.



So, you should ask yourself one question: Considering the sustainability topic that I want to assess and my training objectives, when will be te best time to use a quiz?

Making a personalised quiz involves tailoring the questions or results to the individual characteristics, preferences or experiences of the quiz taker. To make a quiz personalised, you should follow the following steps: identify to which level you want to personalise the quiz; collect information about the quiz taker; customise questions to the profile of the quiz taker; and provide personalised results based on the quiz taker's responses.



So, you should ask yourself one question:
How can I personalise a quiz on sustainability to turn learning
more attractive and effective for the learners I am working
with?
