We have officially started the "VALORISTE: Fostering adults volunteering towards sustainable development through circular economy practices" project, implemented by eight partners, from seven countries, Belgium, Portugal, Greece, Italy, Estonia, Ireland and Poland.

"VALORISTE Agents" are professionals responsible for the recycling and upcycling of stuff and goods. They value and resell the collected objects, extending the life cycle of products and contributing to the goal of achieving a zero-waste society.

The VALORISTE project aims to develop an innovative and attractive training curriculum focused on sustainability and the Circular Economy. This will serve to improve the competence development of low-qualified adults/adults from socially vulnerable groups, in subjects that are strategic and innovative for sustainable development.

The partners met face-to-face in two Transnational Project Meetings (Ireland, 18 November 2022 and Greece, 12 April 2023), wherewith excitement and collaboration they started working on the training programme of the project - an innovative and flexible training programme for future VALORISTE volunteers with six training modules.

Over the next few months, the partnership will work on the implementation of the VALORISTE Toolkit to support adult educators, VALORISTE Agents and other practitioners involved in the Circular Economy.
