The VALORISTE project held its third Transnational Project Meeting in Narva, Estonia on October 17th, and 18th, 2023. Partners from 7 countries—Portugal, Belgium, Greece, Italy, Estonia, Poland, and Ireland—attended the meeting. During the session, partners reviewed and tested the contents of the VALORISTE Training Programme, Toolkit, Digital Stories, and VALORISTE MOOC to ensure their relevance and alignment with project objectives, as the first year of the project draws to a close.

Reflecting on what the consortium has achieved to date, the partnership laid the groundwork for upcoming developments in the next twelve months of the project. This includes:

- Producing the VALORISTE resources in all partner languages
- Uploading the resources to the MOOC
- Developing the Digital Stories
- Piloting the resources with VALORISTE Agents.
