The recent conclusion of the 4th Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) for the VALORISTE Project, which took place in Palermo on April 24, 2024, marked a key moment in the collaborative efforts of seven partner countries: Belgium, Italy, Portugal, Greece, Estonia, Ireland, and Poland.

The TPM started with an insightful demonstration of the "Precious Plastic Project" at the High School "Mario Orso Corbino" in Partinico (Palermo), showcasing an exemplary model of transforming waste into valuable resources for the local community.

Throughout the day, participants engaged in a comprehensive review of the project's progress to date and initiated the Piloting phase. During this session, the partnership outlined key objectives to be accomplished within the next six months of the VALORISTE Project:

1. Conducting a Piloting phase for the VALORISTE online Platform
2. Developing and uploading MOOC Digital Stories and Hands-on lesson plans and piloting them
3. Disseminating and sharing media resources across various platforms
4. Planning Multiplier Events/VALORISTE Forums, with one scheduled for each partner country.



The conclusion of the project is set to be a Final Event in October 2024, hosted in Verviers, Belgium. This event will serve as a platform to highlight the project's outcomes and activities to the public, underlining the collective dedication towards fostering sustainable practices and community empowerment.
