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VALORISTE: Reaching the Final Milestone

After two years of dedicated collaboration among eight European partners, the VALORISTE project is concluding its journey. The project has focused on promoting adult volunteering to advance sustainable development through the principles of a circular economy. At the heart of this initiative are "VALORISTE Agents," individuals who encourage reusing goods. By assessing, collecting, and reselling items, these agents extend the life cycle of products, contributing meaningfully toward a zero-waste future.

Over 70 Learners Engaged in National Pilot Workshops

In the project's final months, pilot workshops were successfully implemented in Belgium, Portugal, Poland, Greece, Estonia, Ireland, and Italy. These training sessions provided educators and adult learners with hands-on experience in sustainable practices and circular economy concepts. Building on months of preparation, the workshops emphasized skill-building, equipping participants with innovative tools and resources to support sustainable development. Learners engaged with VALORISTE's educational materials, including Digital Stories, MOOCs, and the comprehensive VALORISTE Training Programme. These resources enriched participants' knowledge, promoting both personal development and active involvement in their communities.

National Multiplier Events Engage Over 200 Attendees

Another highlight of the project was a series of National Forums, which drew substantial attendance, with 25 to 30 participants at each event. These multiplier events served as platforms to reflect on and celebrate the project's achievements. The Belgian National Forum, held in conjunction with the final Transnational Project Meeting on October 10 and 11 in Verviers, Belgium, brought together all European partners. In this collaborative setting, participants reviewed outcomes, shared successes, and engaged in thoughtful discussions, marking a fitting conclusion to the VALORISTE project.
